### **SAMPLE ENTRY**

Date: 1/12 Title: Keep in God's Love

- **S** Jude 21 "Keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to eternal life."
- Jude's letter is a warning against false teachers and leaders in the church who are after money and who live immoral lifestyles. Jude tells us that as believers we are to keep ourselves in the Spirit (Jude 20) and in God's love (Jude 21).
- A We still hear about many believers falling into greed and immorality. My response needs to be to press in closer to God's heart of love. His love is pure and holy, and the more I understand that, the more I will reflect that love. I will seek to walk daily, not by focusing on more rules and regulations, but by the Spirit's guidance to keep me from sin.
- **P** Dear Lord, thank you for your amazing love. Please help me hear and obey your Spirit's leading today. Help me understand and live in your love.
