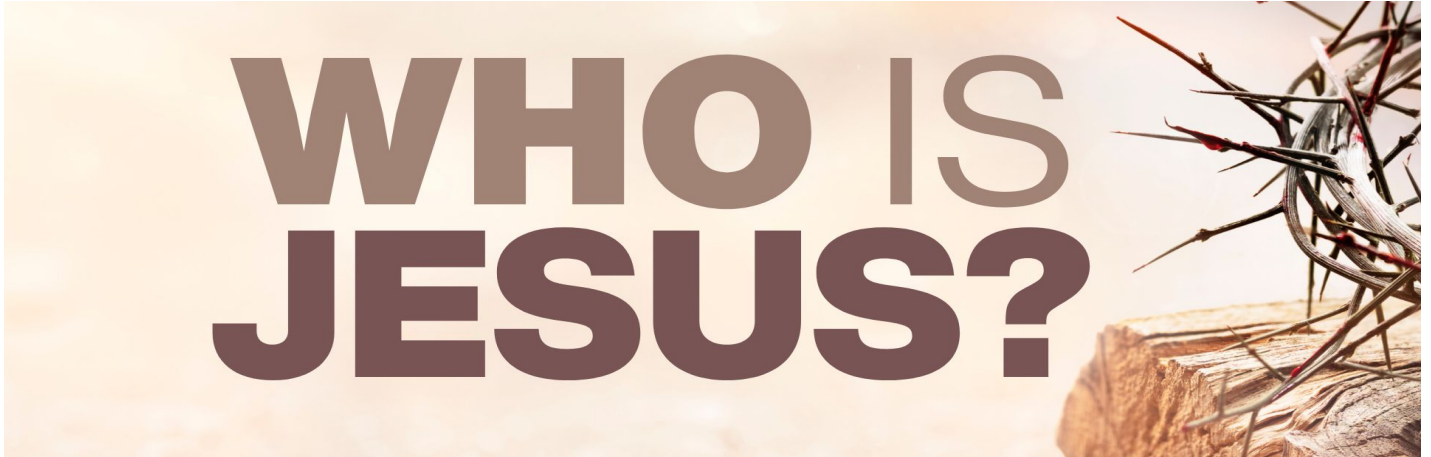


November 19th 2023 Community Group Discussion Questions



Getting Started

- 1) Recall a time where you were part of a large crowd. How many people were there? What was the experience like?
- 2) No doubt many people in the crowd came to Jesus for all sorts of reasons. What originally drew you to Jesus? If you were part of this huge crowd, what would you have wanted Jesus to do for you?
- 3) Have you ever had a nickname? If you could choose your own nickname, what would it be? What if Jesus gave you a nickname like he did for Peter, James and John. What would it be, and what do you think it would reflect?

Digging deeper

- 4) Jesus probably had specific and unique reasons for choosing each of his 12 disciples. He has also chosen you (Eph 1:3-4). What have you learned/are learning about your unique gifting and personality that you think God loves about you?
- 5) Mark 3:13 says that Jesus called “those he wanted”. How does it impact you to hear that Jesus wants you, too?
- 6) Jesus called a group together that would have had a lot of potential for conflict, disagreement and in-fighting. Are you in conflict with anyone? What does it mean to be Jesus’ disciple in the midst of such potential conflict?
- 7) Who might Jesus be calling you to disciple; to do life with and grow together? How would you do that? What’s the next step you need to take?
